### ***FLOC'S NEST: Future Leaders for Christ***

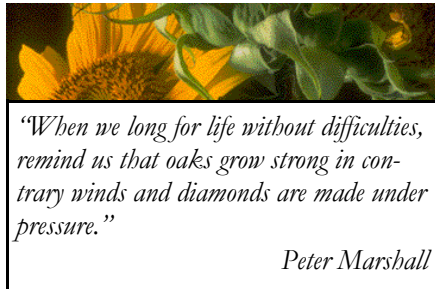
